Dallas. This moving drama explores four generations of women, vividly connecting their personal struggles, dreams and a powerful family secret, culminating in a mysterious and powerful resolution.

For this work, Williams received the Best New American Play Award at the 1999 Harvest Festival of New American Plays and The Larry L. King Award.

She is managing director of
