The format of the event is simple. Each hole is designated with a dollar amount to the winner. If one of the four players has the lowest score after completing a hole, they get the money added to their winnings. If there is a tie on a hole, the money carries over to the next hole. Last year, Fred Funk turned in a record-setting weekend, garnering 15 skins for a total of \$925,000 en route to becoming the oldest Skins Game winner in the event's history.</p> | <p>Tournament Results Champion: Boonchu Ruangkit Purse: \$28,500 2nd Place: Ray Stewart Purse: \$0 3rd Place: Vaughn, Spittle & LaCrosse Purse: \$0</p> | <p>Thai veteran Boonchu Ruangkit completed his wire-to-wire success despite a two-over-par 74 in the final round at the Champions Tour Qualifying School. The 50-year-old fired two birdies against four bogeys and left Canadian Ray Stewart three strokes off the pace in second place after his second straight 69. Boonchu walked away with the top prize of \$28,500 after a winning total of 11-under-par 277 at the TPC Eagle Trace in Coral Springs, Fla. The Thai star is a five-time winner on the Asian Tour and his second place finish on the Order of Merit back in 1995 was his best result to date. It was the first time in PGA Tour history a golfer had reached \$100,000 in a season. Palmer broke the record of \$81,448, which he set a year earlier. Jack Nicklaus also reached six-digit earnings with \$100,040 and finished second on the money list.
