of character and class.

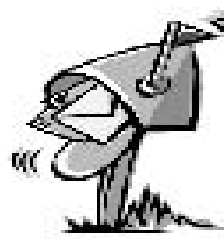
Athletes should meet and the fieldhouse and weightroom.

CHAPTER 6 –CONTRACT REGULATIONS

Section 6.04 Worker's Compensation Insurance Requirements for Contractors

If any company or corporation employing one or more employees contracts with the District for any construction, maintenance or other project, said company or corporation must provide to the District evidence showing said company or corporation has current coverage for Worker's Compensation and liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000 prior to commencing any construction, maintenance or other such project for the District. Failure to provide such proof of insurance will void any contract with said company or corporation. Individual contractors will be covered by the District through its own Worker's Compensation insurance.
