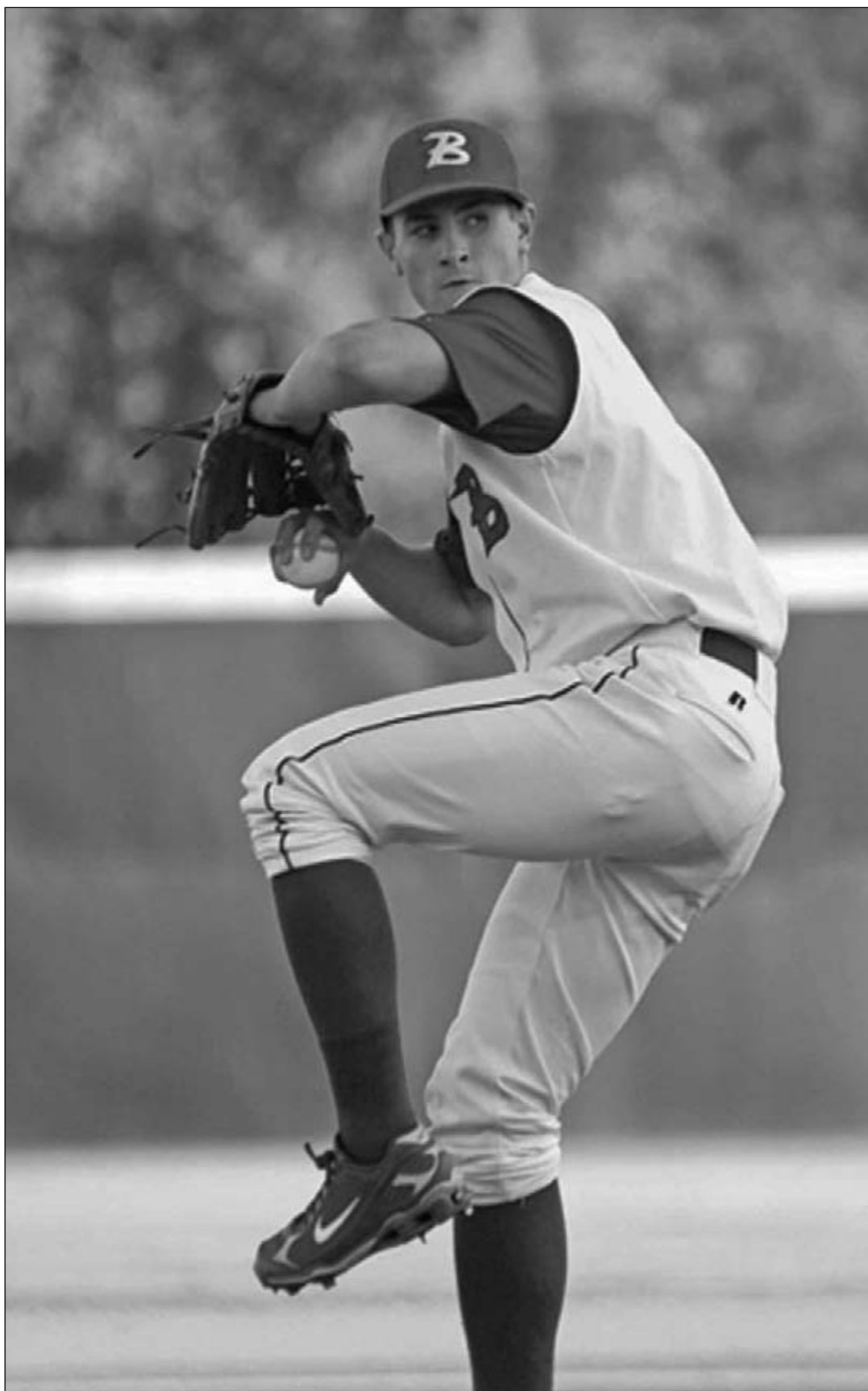

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF BULLARD ZONING ORDINANCE; DIRECTING THE AMENDMENT OF THE ZONING MAP; APPROVING ZONING; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

(Said Ordinance changes the zoning from "R-1a" Single Family Residential District to "C-2" General Commercial District all of Lot 2, Block 6 of Resubdivided Ridgecrest Addition as shown in Cabinet D, Slide 339-D, lot located on west side of Pecan Drive).
