Brook Hill boys sweeps Dallas team in 2 district games

BULLARD - The Brook Hill boys basketball teams made it a two-game district sweep this past Saturday afternoon with wins over The Shelton School of Dallas.

The varsity won by a 59-40 score, and earlier at the lower school gymnasium, the junior varsity took a 32-21, victory.

Mason Spradlin nailed a first quarter 3-pointer to make it 14-4 in the first period, as The Guard tok a 20-11 lead.

Juniors, Jeremy Chappelle, and Courtney Thomas led a 9-2 run for a 27-11 advantage before Spradlin made a steal and a floor-length pass to Austin

Langemeier for an easy two-points and a 29-13 lead.

Both teams swapped out buckets in the third period with 11 points each, but the damage was already done by The Guard, holding a 44-29 lead-way.

Chappelle and Thomas commanded in the paint area down the stretch while point guard, Tyler Baker made a steal and a lay-in for a 54-38 cushion. Spradlin made another steal moments later and finished the scoring with another lay-up.

Chappelle led Brook Hill in scoring with 17 points while Thomas and Baker chipped in with 12 points apiece for the win.

Brook Hill took to the road on Tuesday night to face Dallas Lutheran. For

BULLARD - Collin Hanks nailed three, 3-pointers and led The Guard with 13 points as the eighth-ranked Brook Hill Guard handed the No. 18, TAPPS school, Garland Christian a 55-32 loss at Herrington gym on Thursday night.

Brook Hill won every quarter, putting up double-digits, while the Swordsmen could only muster 15 points in the third period to reach double-digits scoring in a peri-

od. Hanks got plenty of support as Courtney Thomas and Jeremy Chappelle controlled the inside with double-doubles. Thomas scored 11 points and grabbed 10 rebounds, while Chappelle added 10 points and 13 boards.

The junior varsity won their matchup with the Swordsmen as well, 46-28, behind 15 points from Tallen Harris.

Guard gets second district win

BULLARD - Brook Hill got their second district win in as many games this past Tuesday night as The Guard beat Richardson Canyon Creek, 73-30, in TAPPS 4-3A boys action at Herrington gym.

Junior Jeremy Chappelle led all scorers in the game with 34 points and grabbed 15 rebounds in the process. Courtney Thomas, a junior post added a double-double himself with 12 points and 11 boards in the run-away.

The Guard jumped to a 18-3, first quarter lead and stretched it to a 35-12, half-time advantage. Holding Canyon Creek to single-digits in all but the final quarter, Brook Hill rolled up a 57-15 lead after three periods, and finished off the 43-point win outscoring Canyon Creek, 16-13 in the final period.

The win gives The Guard a 14-8 season slate and 2-0 in league play with The Shelton School of Dallas slated for Saturday.

Brook Hill's junior varsity got 18 points from Zachary Cool and another 15 points from Tallen Harris to lead to a 48-24, junior varsity win earlier in the afternoon. The Brook

Hill junior varsity is also 2-0 in league play as The Shelton School comes to Bullard on Saturday.
