

Panthers continue track tune ups for district races

WHITEHOUSE – The Bullard track team trekked to Whitehouse on Saturday to participate as one of 11 teams in the Wildcat Relays, at Wildcat Stadium.

Tyler-Lee took the boy's varsity title over Whitehouse, 134-121, and District 17-3A's Tatum placing third with 101 points.

Not yet at full strength and no relay teams running, the Panthers scored 25 points to place eighth as a team.

Charlie Moore scored 14 of those with a first place in the triple jump, and fourth place in his first 400-meter dash of the season.

David French added 10 points with another first-place in the discus, while Sammy Ferrara took sixth place, adding a point.

The Lady Panthers of Spring Hill, and another district rival for Bullard picked up big points in the relays to beat Whitehouse in the girl's competition. Spring Hill bested Whitehouse, 162-145, with Tatum in fourth place with 55 points, and Bullard taking sixth-place with 33 points.

Ashley Ricci took the lone gold with a win in the high jump, and Bailee Callens took third in the 3200-meter run, and a fourth-place in a photo-finish 1600-meter run.

Kylee Nichols won third in the 800-meter run with her season best time of 2:38.16.

The 4x200 relay won fifth place and the 4x400 meter team brought in a point with a sixth-place. Ashley Frost added a point with a good effort in the 100-meter hurdles.

The junior varsity competition was a boy's only affair with Whitehouse nudging Tyler-Lee 188.333-180 for first-place. Bullard placed seventh with 30 points.

Jace Deece won the pole vault, Kirk Bryant took second and third respectively in the 300-meter hurdles and the 100-meter hurdles.

Jeffery Marshall had a fifth place throw in the discus and two relay teams placed sixth to account for the points.

The Panther track team competes in Troup, Thursday, April 9 before the district met in Tatum, April 15-16.
