

# Five Brook Hill tracksters headed for state in Waco

ARGYLE - After consecutive victories at the East Texas Private School Track and Field Championships, and the TAPPS Class 3A, District 3 championships, the Brook Hill boys track team finished fifth among 12 teams at the TAPPS regional track meet held at Argyle-Liberty Christian last Thursday.

The lone points for the girl's team at regionals came from Jessica Johnson with a second-place finish in the discus.

Four boy's qualified for the state meet later this week in Waco with two athletes with double-medal possibilities.

Not bad for a team that is official seven weeks old now.

Courtney Thomas won the shot put and enters the state meet with the best throw in TAPPS Class3A with a

48'01.50. Guard, junior, Heath Dickey placed fifth in the shot put for additional Brook Hill points. Senior, Chris Dawson had medal hopes but sprained an ankle and was not able to continue.

Thomas will also throw the discus after a third place finish behind teammate, Heath Dickey in second place. Dickey threw 125'8, and Thomas was marked at 125'01.

Junior, Mason Spradlin added to the boy's totals with a fifth-place in the triple jump but did not qualify for the state meet with the top four spots qualifying. Zachary Cool came up inches from placing in the triple jump also for the Guard.

Freshman, Jared Dickey took the silver medal at regionals with the runner-up spot in the 800-meter run running a 2:06.12.

Another freshman, Austin Langemeier has double-medal hopes after placing third in the 1600-meter

run (4:56.69), and fourth in the 3200-meter run (10:43.80). Langemeier also took sixth-place in the high jump

Other Brook Hill finishes include J.B. Moss (seventh, 100-meter dash, eighth, long jump); and Kenai Walker (eighth, 3200-meter run).

Both relay teams took seventh place. The 4X100-meter team of Jamel Bell, Jeremy Chappelle, J.B. Moss, and Gordon Chang clocked in at 46.32, and the 4X400 relay of Jared Dickey, Zachary Cool, Bell, and Langemeier.

For the Lady Guard, Dara Udon placed seventh in both the long jump (15'02.75), and the shot put (27'03.00).

Jessica Johnson qualified for the discus with a throw of 97'11.

Udon also led off the 4X100-meter relay team with Amy Jo Teague, Carley Howard, and Mary Caroline Selden that took eighth place with a time of 55.22.
